## Changes to the DEAC Accreditation Handbook

Following a public call for comment from May 22, 2020 through June 22, 2020, the Commission voted to adopt final changes to Part Two, Processes and Procedures, DEAC *Accreditation Handbook*. The Commission focused its attention on changes that would ensure transparent and clear communication about DEAC's accreditation process to institutions, other quality assurance bodies, government entities, students and the public. The Commission is also responsible for ensuring that DEAC's accreditation procedures align with <u>final regulations</u> governing the recognition of accrediting agencies for postsecondary education. Accordingly, several changes were approved by the Commission to become effective on **July 1, 2020**.

In addition, the Commission adopted final changes to Standard VIII.F, Transfer Credits, DEAC *Accreditation Handbook.* 

In instances where a student seeks to transfer more than the maximum allowable percentage of required credit hours specified in the relevant degree category listed in subsections F.2 through F.5 below, the institution must conduct a comprehensive assessment of the student's credits earned and document how the credits align with its program outcomes. In such cases, transfer credit allowances may not exceed the lesser of any applicable state requirements or 90 percent of the credits required for undergraduate degrees, 75 percent of the credits required for master's degrees or first professional degrees, or 40 percent of the credits required for professional doctoral degrees.
