Myk Garn is an academic innovator and strategist. He focuses on the New Learning Models that occur in the opportunity spaces where teaching and learning are catalyzed by technology including competency-based learning, learning analytics, and artificial intelligence.

In his career, Dr. Garn has worked at colleges, state systems, regional collaboratives, and an Internet start-up. He was the founding Principal Investigator of the NSF AI Institute for Adult Learning and Online Education at Georgia Tech; an Assistant Vice Chancellor for New Learning Models for the University System of Georgia; Vice President for Academic Strategies for StraighterLine; Director of the Educational Technology Cooperative at the Southern Regional Education Board (SREB); Associate Vice President for eLearning at the Kentucky Council for Postsecondary Education; and the founding Chief Academic Officer and then Executive Director of the Kentucky Virtual University. He holds a bachelor's degree from Brooks Institute, a master's degree in Instructional Design from Michigan State, and a PhD in Educational Systems Evaluation from the University of Kentucky.
