Update Regarding the Accreditation Standards: Review and Revisions

The Commission expresses its appreciation to Dr. Ray Rodriguez and the Standards Committee for their dedicated efforts and significant time invested in reviewing revisions to the accreditation standards. Over the past 18 months, DEAC has conducted a thorough and systematic review of its accreditation standards. The Standards Committee

meticulously assessed the latest draft of the standards along with all public and institution feedback received between April 1, 2027 – May 17, 2024.

After carefully considering the recommendations from the Standards Committee and reviewing all comments, the Commission made minor technical adjustments and conforming amendments to the standards based on certain comments it received. Subsequently, a final draft was approved for publication and implementation. The revised Part III, Accreditation Standards, DEAC *Accreditation Handbook* is set to be released on September 1, 2024, with an effective date of January 1, 2025.

DEAC staff will personally reach out to institutions scheduled for on-site evaluations in 2025 to ensure a smooth transition and implementation of the updated standards. We encourage you to mark your calendars for the Accreditation Workshop taking place on October 20-22, 2024, in Portland, Oregon. The workshop will focus on the revised standards that will come into effect on January 1, 2025.
