

Report from the Accrediting Commission March 7, 2025

The Distance Education Accrediting Commission (the Commission) met on January 24, 2025. This report summarizes the accreditation actions taken by the Accrediting Commission on January 24, 2025, in accordance with its procedure for Notification and Information Sharing (Section XV.C. and G.), Part Two, Processes and Procedures, *DEAC Accreditation Handbook*.

Denial of Accreditation:

The Commission acted to deny initial accreditation to the following institution:

ADEN University was provided written notice of this action on February 24, 2025. ADEN was given until March 6, 2025 to notify DEAC of its intention to appeal. DEAC did not receive an application to appeal; therefore, the Commission's action is final. ADEN has been provided with written notice of the opportunity to provide official comments on the Commission's decision. Comments must be submitted by March 21, 2025.
